The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(b) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus so as to direct the respondents to extend the parole of the petitioner for four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in FIR No.312 dated 03.06.2000 *inter alia* under Section 302 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Gurugram, the petitioner was convicted and sentenced to undergone rigorous imprisonment for a period of 14 years and out of which, he has already undergone actual imprisonment of 10 years.

He further submits that the petitioner is not keeping well and is getting treatment from Medanta Hospital, Gurugram for which he is required to be released on parole for one month. He submits that the jail authorities are competent to grant parole to the petitioner. For seeking parole, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 23.02.2021 (Annexure P-12) to the Home Secretary, Haryana.

At this stage, he seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to move an appropriate application to the competent jail authority seeking parole on the pleaded grounds.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner submits a representation before the competent jail authority seeking parole within one week from today, this Court expects that the authority concerned shall take note of such representation and shall take a final call on such representation within another 10 days from the date of such receipt.
