The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.279 dated 23.12.2020, under Sections 306, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that deceased-Bharti Sharma had committed suicide because she was in financial difficulty and could not return the money which she owed to the people who had invested in committee business.

Heard.

This is the second petition which has been preferred for grant of anticipatory bail. The first petition preferred by the petitioner bearing CRM-M-4997-2021 was dismissed on 24.02.2021 as the learned counsel after arguing for sometime, had sought its withdrawal. The allegations against the petitioner are that he had been harassing the deceased-Bharti Sharma. In the occurrence, Bharti Sharma along with her two family members had committed

suicide. The petitioner had allegedly posted on Facebook defaming the deceased-Bharti Sharma prior to her committing suicide. Therefore, I do not deem it appropriate to take another view in the matter as the previous petition has already been dismissed.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
