The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 134 dated 01.09.2014 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on instructions of this Court dated 02.03.2020, the petitioner appeared before the trial Court and joined the proceedings before the trial Court. He was admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds before the said Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating

Officer submits that the petitioner has joined the proceedings.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 02.03.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
