The grievance of the petitioner-bank is that the application dated 23.1.2020 (**Annexure P-6**) filed under Section 14 of the Securitisation and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Securities Interest Act, 2002, for providing physical possession of the secured asset has still not been decided by the District Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Ms. Anu Pal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who was on advance notice, has furnished a copy of order dated 3.3.2021 passed by District Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib vide which it has been ordered for handing over the physical possession of the secured assets and Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has been directed to provide police assistance to the petitioner-bank. Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has also been directed to appoint Duty Magistrate for the said purpose.

In view of the aforesaid factual matrix, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that nothing more survives in the present writ petition for adjudication.

In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
