The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.210 dated 11.09.2020, registered under Section 18 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar (Rural).

The operative part of the order dated 05.03.2021, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 29.01.2021 passed in CRM-M-37917, 34992 & 21864-2020, vide which co-accused Sapanmanpreet Kaur and Amarjit Singh @ Babbu were granted concession of interim regular bail as well as order dated 09.02.2021 passed in CRM-M-5033-2021, vide which another co-accused Dilbagh Singh was granted interim regular bail by this Court. It is submitted that the petitioner was nominated in the FIR later, on the basis of disclosure statement of aforesaid three co-accused.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 05.03.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Shivender Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.03.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
