This appeal has been filed against the order of the learned Single Judge wherein, this Court had refused to interfere in the transfer of the appellant from Guhla to Pehowa.

The claim of the appellant was that he is 70% disabled and therefore, he should not have been transferred to a place, which is 50 kilometers away from the place of his posting. Learned Single Bench noticed that the disability of the appellant was in one leg and held that it was not a case for exercise of extraordinary jurisdiction.

We find no reason to interfere in the order of the learned Single Judge and the appeal is accordingly dismissed.
