Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.11 dated 23.01.2020 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural.

Vide order dated 19.02.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 19.02.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Harbhajan Lal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation

and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 19.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
