SANT PARKASH, J.

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.68 dated 23.02.2021 registered under Section 365 IPC at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

The facts pleaded are that the petitioner and respondent No.3 are living together in a live-in relationship against the wishes of complainant (uncle of respondent No.3) as well as the family members of respondent No.3. It is averred that due to adamant behaviour of her parents, respondent No.3 left her house with the petitioner. On account of this, complainant (uncle of respondent No.3) has got registered the above-said FIR against the petitioner on the allegation that petitioner had enticed away

respondent No.3.

Today, at the time of resumed hearing, learned counsel for State has placed on record an affidavit dated 05.04.2021 of Kulbir Kaur, Inspector/SHO, Police Station, Taraori, District Karnal. The relevant part thereof reads as under:-

“That during the course of investigation, the deponent also verified the fact and found that there is no danger or threat to the appellants namely Vidisha Goyal and Pankul at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 6 parents and brother of the appellant no.1. Now Vidisha Goyal is living with Pankul, appellant no.2 with her own volition. Cancellation report in case FIR No.68 dated 23.02.2021 under section 365 IPC of Police Station, Taraori has been written on 02.04.2021 in this case. After completing due procedure, cancellation report in this case will be submitted in the learned trial court immediately, as no case of entice is made out.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
