The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.6 dated 10.1.2020 registered under Sections 323, 377, 498-A, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

By virtue of the order dated 19.2.2020, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ranjeet Sharma has endorsed the same and submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 19.2.2020 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
