This case is taken up out of turn on request of learned counsel for the parties, with the matter having been settled between them.

Pursuant to the order of this court dated 06.10.2021, the report of the learned Mediator in the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this court has been received (dated 28.10.2021), stating to the effect that the petitioner and respondent no.2 have settled the matter with each other as per the settlement agreement drawn up on that date, as has also been annexed with the report.

Learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent no.2 are *ad idem* that the settlement is still operative.

Learned counsel for respondent no.2 further submits that in terms of settlement, a demand draft for an amount of Rs.3,50,000/- has also been received by respondent no.2, with nothing further due to her from the petitioner.

The petition being one impugning the judgments of the learned courts below convicting the petitioner for the commission of an offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, and the orders of imprisonment imposed, consequently upon the matter having been amicably settled between the parties and it being a compoundable offence under Section 147 of the said Act, the petition is allowed, with the judgments of the learned courts below and the orders of sentence passed against the petitioner, set aside; and the petitioner, consequently, acquitted of the charges framed against him.
