The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.46 dated 18.02.2020 under Sections 21, 22-C/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sadar Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused from whom 261.84 grams of intoxicant power (heroin) was allegedly recovered. No recovery was effected from the petitioner even after his arrest in this case. He also contends that the petitioner is 23 years of age and is in custody for over one year and four months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Leelu Ram, states that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined. He also contends that the petitioner is involved in another case under the NDPS Act.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when no recovery has been effected from the petitioner, he is 23 years of age, he is in custody for over one year and four months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
