1. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.25 dated 16.02.2021, registered under Sections 306 and 34 Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.
