By these petitions, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.45, dated 12.03.2019, registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondents no.2, Kamalpreet Kaur.

Pursuant to the order dated 08.11.2019, the report of the learned JMIC, Patiala, dated 18.03.2020, has been received, stating therein that the complainant in the FIR, i.e. respondent no.2, Kamalpreet Kaur, as also the person holding a power of attorney executed by the petitioner, appeared before

that court alongwith the investigating officer, with the complainant stating that the matter has been compromised between the parties without any pressure, coercion and influence, and with the attorney of the present petitioner (i.e. Manjit Kaur attorney of Harjinder Singh), also having suffered a statement to that effect.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent no.2 also submits that the said respondent, i.e. complainant in the FIR, has no objection to the FIR being quashed *qua* all the accused therein, the matter having been fully compromised between the parties.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed by the petitioners and the fact that the dispute has been amicably settled between the parties, I see no purpose in keeping pending the criminal proceedings any further against the petitioners, with therefore the petition allowed and FIR No.45, dated 12.03.2019, registered at Police Station Tripuri, District Patiala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, hereby quashed.
