Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 99 dated 14.10.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Bahin, District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been attributed any injury and it is alleged that the petitioner had caught hold of the injured. The injured had received a solitary gunshot injury at the hands of co-accused, namely, Jagvir @ Bhola, who is in custody. The petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 09.03.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rashid Khan, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 09.03.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
