1. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order dated 30.09.2020 passed in compliance of order dated 26.08.2020 in CWP No.12759 of 2020 having been supplied to him today in the morning, and the claim of the petitioner having been rejected, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the contempt petition with liberty to challenge order dated 30.09.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law. Order dated 30.09.2020 is taken on record.

2. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. AG, Haryana states that non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional but due to administrative exigencies on account of circumstances prevailing due to coronavirus pandemic and in view of order dated 30.09.2020 having been passed in compliance of order dated 26.08.2020 in CWP No.12759 of 2020 the contempt petition be disposed of as not calling for any orders.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel and am of the view that in the peculiar prevailing circumstances, non compliance within the stipulated period of time was not intentional or willful.

3. In view of the position noted above, no action is called for on the Contempt Petition and the same is disposed of as such while granting

liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 30.09.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
