1. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.114 dated 18.02.2021 registered under Sections 120-B, 323, 34, 365, 506 IPC at Police Station City Sonipat, District Sonipat.
