Mr. Randeep Rai, learned Senior Advocate with Mr. Harsh Bungar, learned Advocate, at the threshold, has stated that a compromise has been effected between the petitioner and the Trust through their Members/Secretary on 22.03.2021. He has stated that the compromise deed has been sent on email in view of the fact that the present proceedings are being taken up by way of video conferencing today. He has further submitted that in view of the compromise deed, he does not wish to press the present petition and prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

The compromise deed is hereby taken on record and directed to be attached with the paper-book as Mark-X.

Mr. Vikas Bahl, learned Senior Advocate with Mr. Vijay Sharma, learned Advocate, who is appearing on behalf of respondent No.8 (added respondent), which is the Trust with whom the aforesaid compromise has taken place has categorically submitted that it is correct that the said compromise dated 22.03.2021 has taken place and the dispute *inter se* between the parties has since been settled.

Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 7 states that she has no objection in case the petitioner withdraws the petition.

In view of the aforesaid position and the statements made by the learned counsel for the parties, the prayer of the petitioner for withdrawal of the present petition is accepted.

The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

All the interim orders made in the present petition, hereby, stand vacated.
