State Counsel has produced the original OMR answer-sheet of the petitioner, for the post of Art & Craft Teacher.

A perusal of the same would go on to show that there is smudging in question No.1 (A) at option 'C' and thereafter, option 'D' had been filled-up. In such circumstances, the OMR sheet had not been corrected by the Commission. Resultantly, this Court is of the opinion that the matter is governed by the judgment passed by this Court in CWP-4938-2021 titled *Nishant Singh Vs State of Haryana & others*, decided on 05.07.2021 and therefore, no benefit is liable to be granted to the petitioner as his answer-sheet was rightly not considered for the post of Art & Crafts Teacher. It is also not disputed that the petitioner was not selected in the earlier appointments made in 2010 qua advertisement No.6 of 2006 and therefore, no sympathetic consideration can also be granted to him which has been given to a certain set of similarly situated candidates.

Accordingly, in view of the above, finding no merit in the present writ petition, the same is hereby dismissed. The original OMR answer-sheet of the petitioner be returned to the State Counsel.
