1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 06.10.2020.
3. Learned counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to comply with order Annexure P/1 dated 06.10.2020, by deciding representation dated 18.07.2020, in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order, preferably within two months from the date of order. Learned counsel contends that after the filing of the contempt petition, the respondent has decided the representation and granted the petitioner relief as per her entitlement, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.
4. In view of representation dated 18.07.2020, having been

decided and the petitioner having been released the benefits as per her entitlement, besides, statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
