This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.309 dated 16.12.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 332, 353, 379-B of IPC and Section 21 (4) of Mines and Minerals (Regulation of Development Act, 1957 (added later on), registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

On 17.08.2021, this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Parveen Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not

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required for further investigation.

This Court has heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances as also the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and also the argument of the learned counsel for the petitioner that it is highly improbable that the petitioner and the other persons would be able to brow beat the police officials who had as per the version in the FIR come to the spot after secret/private information, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 17.08.2021 is made absolute.

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial would proceed independently of the observations made in the present case which are only for the purpose of adjudicating the present bail application.
