The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this writ petition, the petitioners pray for the issuance of an appropriate direction to the respondents to stop the construction of a storm water disposal plant being constructed at Adarsh Nagar, Ward No.23, Municipal Corporation, Panipat.

The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that a space earmarked for a park is being used for constructing a storm water disposal plant. He submits that it should have been located at some other place.

In the considered view of this Court, this aspect of the matter can only be examined by an appropriate authority who has expertise in the field. The learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Naveen, XEN, MC Panipat, submits that pipes to take the storm as well as dirty water have already been laid and the storm water disposal plant is likely to come up in a

short period. He submits that the officials of the Municipal Corporation are taking steps in order to redress the grievances of the residents of Weaver Colony as well as Adarsh Nagar.

Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken, the writ petition is disposed of. If the petitioners are still aggrieved, they may avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
