Prayer in this petition is for setting-aside the order dated 29.07.2019 passed by the trial Court vide which the petitioners were declared as proclaimed offenders in FIR No.308 dated 14.10.2017 registered under Sections 307/336/148/149 IPC, 25 of the Arms Act, (Sections 323/324/325/326/201 IPC and 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, added later) at Police Station 'A' Division, Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioners has relied upon the order of even date passed in CRM-M No.10858 of 2021, to submit that since the matter has already been compromised, the petitioners are ready to surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail.

Considering the fact that the petitioners were declared as proclaimed offenders on 29.07.2019, however later on, the matter has been compromised between the parties, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail and the same will be allowed subject to furnishing bail/surety bonds, considering the

fact that the matter stands compromised.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of.

This will, however, be subject to payment of costs of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with the Punjab & Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.

The receipt of the same will be produced before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate at the time of recording the statement of the parties.
