This petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. Further to direct Gurgaon Police to lodge FIR and immediately seize evidences on heinous crimes of drugs peddling, sexual exploitation, hawala transactions, etc., while setting aside the order of Addl. Sessions Judge, who committed grave mistake in reversing order of JMIC.

Petitioner contends that the jurisdiction exercised by the Magistrate under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. vide order dated 18.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) was justified and the revisional Court exceeded its jurisdiction by intervening with the interlocutory order, through impugned order dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-1).

When confronted with the maintainability of the petition,

petitioner wishes to withdraw this petition to file fresh petition under

appropriate provisions of law, on the same cause of action.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn with the
above liberty.
