The present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C., seeking cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondents No.2 and 3 in case FIR No.47 dated 22.10.2020 under Section 498-A, 406 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Women Cell District Amritsar.

The only grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.2 still has some of her educational certificates in his possession and hence, the Court below erred in extending the concession of anticipatory bail to him.

Learned counsel for the respondents has however refuted the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that no such educational certificates are in the possession of any of respondents.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the material available on record.

No ground is made out to accept the prayer of the petitioner inasmuch as she has failed to bring to the notice of this Court any violation

of any of the conditions, which were imposed on respondent No.2 by the trial Court while granting him the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 03.02.2021.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
