The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 74 dated 26.07.2018, registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station pending before JMIC, Moga, Punjab.

On 19.02.2020, the following order was passed:-

“Submits inter alia that death of the victim, namely, Sukhtej Singh occurred more than 2½ years ago in the month of December, 2017 and summons were ordered to be issued against the petitioners at a very belated stage.

Submits further that even the complaint as filed, does not disclose any specific instance of harassment or instigation to the victim to kill himself.

Notice of motion for 14.05.2020.

In the meantime, Petitioner is directed to appear before the Ld. Trial Court within 10 days from today upon doing so, he shall be released on an interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court. The Petitioner shall, however, appear as and

when called for and shall also abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 19.02.2020, has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 19.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
