The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 13.05.2013 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station City Phagwara.

The operative part of the order dated 24.02.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

It is further submitted that he has instructions from the petitioner to say that the petitioner does not want to challenge the order summoning him as additional accused and is ready to face the trial.
