Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.251 dated 30.09.2020, registered under Sections 171, 392, 394 and 397 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is a business rivalry between the petitioner and the complainant. Since, some amount is due towards the petitioner, he has falsely been implicated in the present FIR.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Apoorv Garg, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and has pointed out that the petitioner is also involved in four other criminal cases.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned State counsel.

In the present case, the petitioner has committed a robbery on the

gun point. Apart from this, the petitioner has also been involved in four other criminal cases out of which he has already been convicted in two cases. The allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature.

Keeping in view the above, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
