By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR No.161, dated 12.04.2020, having been registered at Police Station Civil Lines Karnal, District Karnal, alleging therein the commission of offence punishable under Section 67 of the Information and Technology Act and Section 509 of the IPC.

A reply dated 18.03.2021, by way of an affidavit of Shri Vijay Deshwal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Karnal, has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Roshan Lal, submits that pursuant to the order dated 08.03.2021, the petitioner having joined the investigation and his mobile phone having been taken into custody, his

Custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, if the petitioner's custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days' notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of proper investigation, she would be always at liberty to avail of her remedy as per law.
