JAISHREE THAKUR, J.(Oral)

This is a petition that has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 08 dated 19.02.2021 registered under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station Women, Patiala, Punjab.

By an order dated 09.03.2021, the arrest of the petitioner had been stayed limited to enable him to try and effect mediation between the parties. Consequently the parties had been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Today the connected petition for quashing of the same FIR is also listed wherein it is stated that the matter stands compromised between

the parties and they have been directed to get their statements recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant too admits to the factum of the compromise between the parties.

Consequent thereto, nothing survives in the instant petition as the matter stands compromised between the parties. The petition is disposed of and order dated 09.03.2021 staying the arrest of the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

Needless to say, in case the terms of the compromise are not adhered to in totality by the petitioner, the respondent-State and respondent No.2/complainant are at liberty to get the petition revived at any stage.

Other miscellaneous applications, if any, pending on date are disposed of accordingly.
