The case has been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under
Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.125 dated
02.04.2018 registered under Sections 147, 149, 188, 283, 341
of the Indian Penal Code and Section 8B of the National
Highway Act, 1956, Police Station Civil Lines, Gurugram, District
Gurugram.

On 26.02.2020, following order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends
that the offences under Indian Penal Code
are bailable except the offence under Section 8-B of
National Highway Act, 1956. In the very nature of
allegations, the offence under Section 8-B of National
Highway Act, 1956 is not attracted.*

Notice of motion for 30.04.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 01.03.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further custodial interrogation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 26.02.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
