The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count the work-charged service followed by deceased's regularization for the purposes of pensionary benefits in view of the rules governing his condition of service, for which, legal notice dated 14.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner's side the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider legal notice dated 14.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
