Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to allot the permanent posting in the district according to the preference given by the petitioner.

At the outset, instead of pressing the petition on merits, learned Counsel for the petitioner has confined his prayer to the extent that his client will make a representation and the same be considered expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Notice of motion.

Learned State Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in case the innocuous prayer of the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with liberty to the petitioner to make a comprehensive representation to the competent authority i.e. respondent No.2-Director, Elementary Education within a period of one week from today and in case of his doing so, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously in accordance with the rules and instructions in vogue by passing a speaking order within two weeks thereafter.
