The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.11 dated 10.02.2018 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the petitioner was on bail and was regularly appearing before the trial Court. However, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 15.03.2019 due to some unavoidable domestic problem and, therefore, his bail was cancelled by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurdaspur vide order dated 15.03.2019 (Annexure P-1) and ultimately, the petitioner was declared as a proclaimed person on 25.07.2019.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, however, with liberty to file an appropriate application seeking regular bail before the trial Court.

Considering the fact that the petitioner was on bail in this case and he has shown his inclination to surrender before the trial Court so as to seek regular bail, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and moves an application to seek regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour to decide the same within a week from the date of filing such application.
