Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view certain developments after filing of the present writ petitions, which need to be brought on record including the challenge to the decision by the Policy Management Committee, he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petitions with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars and also by challenging the decision of the Policy Management Committee.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) further submits that in the present writ petitions an interim order was passed by this Court on 27.02.2020 in favour of the petitioners.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the respondents submits that on an application filed by the respondents seeking vacation of interim order, the petitioners had already given an undertaking on 01.12.2020 that till the application for vacation of interim stay is not decided, they will not press their claim for the grant of insurance amount on the basis of the policies in terms of order dated 27.02.2020.

Be that as it may, the position as it exists today in respect of the order passed in these petitions including the order dated 27.02.2021 as well as undertaking given by the petitioners, the same will continue to operate

for a period of two weeks from today so as to enable the petitioners to approach this Court again, in case, they so desire by filing a fresh writ petition.

The present writ petitions are allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with the conditions stated hereinbefore.
