Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.152 dated 14.11.2019 registered under Section 406 IPC at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 20.02.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation and notice was issued to respondent No.2, who is daughter-in-law of the petitioner.

As per office report, respondent No.2 is not residing at the given address.

On 20.08.2021, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Sohan Lal, submitted that the petitioner had already joined the investigation and was not required for any further investigation.

Since, the respondent No.2 is not residing at the given address, service upon her is dispensed with.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.02.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
