In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 15.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, any substance is found in the representation filed, appropriate action be taken in the matter.
