Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 5 dated 11.01.2020, registered under Sections 452, 325, 323 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

The operative part of the order dated 24.02.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner was empty handed and there is no allegation that he has given any injury to anyone.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.02.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Harjinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that *challan* stands presented.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
