LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in CM-9221-CWP-2021, is for restraining the inhabitants of village Jasana, Sub Tehsil Tegaon, District Faridabad from throwing the garbage/manure in abadi area of village as well as in front of residential houses of the applicants/petitioners. Above said writ petition stands adjourned to 11.10.2021 due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19. Though notice of motion was not issued in this writ petition, learned counsel for the State was asked to seek instructions on 04.03.2020 in respect to

submission that manure pits are not shifted away from the residential area of the village despite instructions to all Gram Panchayats.

Learned counsel for the petitioners and State are *ad-idem* that the writ petition itself be taken up for hearing today.

At oral request of learned counsel, hearing of the writ petition is preponed from 11.10.2021 for today itself.

Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to ensure that manure/garbage etc. is not dumped in front of residential houses of the petitioners and other villagers of the area. Learned counsel refers to communication dated 08.12.2002 by the BDPO, Faridabad to submit that garbage etc. could not be permitted to be dumped near the village abadi.

Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana, submits that no representation whatsoever has been received from petitioners, though, learned counsel for the petitioners has referred to an application/representation dated 12.12.2002 (Annexure P7) addressed to Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the State submits that in case a comprehensive representation is received, same shall be looked into and dealt with, in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, it is directed that present writ petition be treated to be a representation on behalf of petitioners and competent authority/authorities shall look into the matter and decide the same after affording an opportunity of hearing to petitioners in

accordance with law, within a period of two months from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Writ petition is disposed of accordingly.
