The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus seeking release of detenues named in para 4 of the petition from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated 18.02.2020, this Court issued notice to the respondents and directed the District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, District Ropar (Punjab) to enquire into the averments made in the petition and submit a report.

In compliance of the said order, a short affidavit dated 27.02.2020 of District Magistrate, Rupnagar has been filed wherein it has been deposed that after conducting an enquiry, it was found that none of the persons mentioned in the petition were found to be detained in the brick kiln.

In view of the above affidavit, no further order is called for.

Petition is dismissed.
