1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.212 dated 28.09.2020 registered under Sections 61 and 78 Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Sadar District Bathinda.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 10.03.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from *ASI KauharSingh*, confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 10.03.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the same, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.
