1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.71 dated 20.04.2020 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 188, 285 and 506 IPC and Section 25, 54, 59 Arms Act registered at Police Station Bichhor, District Nuh.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 10.03.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, fully cooperated with the police, was released on ad interim pre arrest bail and that his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Learned DAG, Haryana, on instructions from *HC Navneet Singh* confirms that pursuant to the order of this Court dated 10.03.2021, the petitioner joined investigation, cooperated in the investigation, was released on ad-interim pre-arrest bail and his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. In view of the statement of the learned DAG, Haryana, order dated 10.03.2021 passed by this Court, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions enumerated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
