The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for the grant of regular bail in FIR No.158 dated 01.08.2020 registered under Sections 379, 511, 420 and 120 IPC at Police Station City Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition on its merits and would be satisfied if the same is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the above alternate prayer made by the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above and because there are only seven prosecution witnesses in the petitioner's trial as also for the reason that the petitioner has been in custody for the last over one year and two months, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court that, subject to the cooperation of the petitioner and his counsel, the petitioner's trial be disposed of within five months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.
