This is a writ petition that has been filed for extension of two weeks parole to the petitioner beyond 15.03.2021 on the ground that he has to solemnize his own marriage on 05.04.2021.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. P.P. Chahar, DAG Haryana, who is present in the court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He contends that the petitioner herein is a life convict in FIR No.293 dated 22.10.2002, under Section 304-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak and in fact, has undergone 14 years, 03 months and 28 days actual sentence, as per custody certificate attached by counsel for the petitioner as Annexure P2. It is argued that in fact, the petitioner has to apply afresh on his surrender on 15.03.2021. Counsel for the respondent-

State is unaware about the factum of marriage of the petitioner scheduled to be held on 05.04.2021.

Faced with this, counsel for the petitioner herein prays that this petition itself be treated as a representation of the petitioner for consideration of his parole to solemnize the marriage as per wedding card that has been attached as Annexure P4 with the petition.

The request is acceded to.

This petition is ordered to be treated as a representation of the petitioner for his parole to solemnize the marriage. As the petitioner is already on parole till 15.03.2021, he is directed to surrender before the concerned jail authorities on the due date i.e. 15.03.2021. The concerned jail authorities are directed to take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner within three days from the date of his surrender.

Needless to say, the petitioner is at liberty to approach to this court in case he desires so.

The instant criminal writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid directions.
