The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0035 dated 16.01.2021 under Sections 406, 420 and 506 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, Haryana.

The operative part of the order dated 09.03.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case; after the inquiry in which the petitioner had taken part the police has exonerated the petitioner; there is no other criminal case in which the petitioner is involved; even if the case of the prosecution is taken as the gospel truth, though vehemently denied, the entire amount of Rs.5 lakhs received by the petitioner from the complainant was transferred to the account of co-accused Mohit Nagpal and that he is also ready and willing to join the investigation as and when called by the investigating agency.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Addl. A. G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

For arguments, adjourned to 17.05.2021.

Before the adjourned date, the State shall file a status report.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 09.03.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Ajaib Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 09.03.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
