Petition herein is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to declare the result of the petitioner for the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) or in the alternate to disclose the actual marks scored by him in the Examination.

2. Pursuant to order dated 24.08.2021, the result of the petitioner has been received in a sealed cover, which has been opened during the Court proceedings. The same reveals that he has secured an aggregate of 56 marks (51 marks in the written examination + 05 marks towards socio-economic criteria).

3. In the premise, it seems that being unaware of his actual result, the petitioner was misled into filing the instant petition premised on an understanding that he had obtained 53 marks in the written examination, and after awarding of 05 marks towards socio-economic criteria, his aggregate

being 58 marks and yet he has not been given the benefit, despite being more meritorious. However, he has actually scored 56 aggregate marks.

4. The result of the petitioner is not under challenge before this Court.

Being so, no further grounds to interfere are made out.

5. Dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to follow up his pending representation qua rest of his grievance. Dismissal of the instant petition will not come in the way of the respondents to consider the same in accordance with law.
