Case taken up through video conferencing.

Petitioner Akash Dubey has filed the instant civil writ petition against respondents i.e. State of Haryana through its Secretary, Department of Local government, Haryana and Executive Officer, Municipal Corporation, Yamuna Nagar, craving for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide his representation dated 4.8.2020, copy Annexure P-4 for appointment on compassionate ground for the reason that his father Sh.Ram Kumar Dubey, who was working as MALI with respondent No.2 had died while in service. According to him, he had submitted a representation dated 4.8.2020 addressed to respondent No.2 – Executive Officer, Municipal Corporation, Yamuna Nagar but that has not evoked any response, as such he had to file the present civil writ petition.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits

that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of his representation Annexure P4 within a fixed time frame.

Under the circumstances, the present civil writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioner, copy Annexure P4 and to take necessary action in the matter, in accordance with law, if it is so warranted by facts and circumstances of the case. A speaking order in that regard be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

In case the petitioner still feels dissatisfied after disposal of the representation by respondents, then he may take recourse to the legal remedy again in accordance with law.
