The petitioners have approached this Court, by way of filing the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking protection of their life and liberty on the premise that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage with petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and other family members and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

A perusal of the present petition shows that in para 12, it is stated that this is the second marriage of both the petitioners and neither any explanation is given whether the petitioners have taken divorce from their previous spouses nor it is disclosed whether they have any child from the previous marriage and if so, who will look after the minor children.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed granting liberty to petitioners to file afresh by giving all the details.
