HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 485 dated 21.08.2016, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Ratia, District Fatehabad.

As per the allegations in the FIR, on 21.08.2016, one Dalbir Singh was apprehended with the contraband i.e. 440 grams of opium. He named the present petitioner as the supplier of the said contraband.

The petitioner was arrested on 21.02.2017, thereafter, he was released on regular bail vide order dated 30.03.2017 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad. After the concession of bail, the petitioner was regularly appearing before learned trial Court, but on 16.07.2018, he did not appear before trial Court because of which his bail was cancelled.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is suffering from acute promyelocytic leukemia. He has also

annexed copy of the medical record. Learned counsel states that the non-appearance of the petitioner before learned trial Court was not intentional. It was on account of the fact that he was undergoing treatment for the said disease. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner undertakes to appear before the learned trial Court on any date to be fixed by this Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tapan Kumar Yadav, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Meanwhile, the petitioner may appear before the learned trial Court on or before 25.03.2021. On his doing so, he shall be enlarged on bail by the trial Court subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction. He shall also file an undertaking before the trial Court to continue appearing as and when required apart from following all the terms and conditions fixed in this respect.
