GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0132 dated 22.04.2020 at Police Station City Tarn Taran, under Sections 452/323/325/506/34 IPC.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion on 10.03.2021, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that only non-bailable offence is under Section 452 IPC. In respect of occurrence dated 05.03.2020, FIR was registered only on 24.04.2020 i.e. after a delay of 49 days. The role attributed to the petitioner is that the petitioner gave sota blow on the person of son of the complainant, hitting him on his forehead. The injury is found to be grievous falling under Section 325 IPC which is bailable in nature. Threat of killing in terms of Section 506 IPC would remain debatable.

Notice of motion for 13.05.2021.

Till the next date of hearing, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.”

3. Subsequently, vide order dated 02.09.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation. It has also been informed that the petitioner is not wanted in any other case.
5. Having regard to the aforestated position wherein the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 02.09.2021 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
