The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the impugned order dated 12.02.2020 (Annexure P-1), whereby the application of the petitioner for grant of eight weeks of parole has been rejected.

Learned State counsel has filed its reply by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Maximum Security Jail, Nabha in which it has been mentioned in Paragraph 6 that the petitioner was released on parole on 01.04.2020 with a direction to surrender on 28.05.2020. But due to Covid-2019 pandemic, the parole of the petitioner was extended from time to time as per the recommendations of High Powered Committee and Govt. of Punjab till 19.03.2021. The petitioner was informed to surrender back at District Jail, Barnala on 19.03.2021 but he did not surrender back as informed and has been absconding ever since.

In view of the above, the present petition is devoid of any merit and is hereby dismissed.
